4. Discussion and Recommendation re:

A. [ID#19-0273](#) Please approve changing the parking restriction time in Municipal Lot 13 from No Parking, 2am – 5am, Except with Permit to No Parking, 3am – 5am, Except with Permit on Friday and Saturday nights only.

Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Ald. Eric Payne. A business nearby Lot 13 at corner of St. Paul & Madison has expressed concern that patron parking in Lot 13 have gotten tickets at or shortly after 2:00 am. Since this business has patrons and staff that stay as late as 3:00 am, they would like to have the time change, at this lot only, to No Parking 3:00 am to 5:00 am on weekend Fridays and Saturday nights only. Just to be clear, it would be 3:00-5:00am Saturday morning and 3:00-5:00am Sunday morning. The Department of Public Works does not approve of changing the overnight parking time and recommends no action be taken on this item. The Downtown Parking Adhoc Committee has established the No Parking time of 2:00 am to 5:00 am to a uniform throughout the City. If the committee feels that this item should be acted on, it would require a change to the City parking ordinance. Chapter 7.04 (b, c) indicates that there will be No Parking in the downtown Central Business District area from 2:00 am to 5:00 am. Municipal Lot 13 falls within the downtown Central Business District.

Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Public Works with endorsement from the Fire Department and Ald. Skinner. During winter months, this street becomes very narrow with snow build up. A recent fire call was made to this street and the fire department could not make it to the resident with their vehicle. The issue is overnight parked vehicles are not moved in time to affectively clear the snow. This item would prohibit overnight parking in on the north side of this street during November to April.
