3. Discussion and Recommendation re:

A. [ID#17-1068](#) Please approve the installation of two Way-Finding signs for Bethesda Park to be installed near the intersection of N. West Ave. and Dunbar Ave. and near the intersection of W. College Ave. and Dunbar Ave. Funding for the installation of the said signs will be provided by the Dunbar Oaks Neighborhood Association.

Recommendation: Ald. Helgestad referred this item. Members of the Dunbar Oaks Neighborhood Association are seeking permission to have way-finding signs placed at key locations to assist drivers looking for Bethesda Park. The cost of the signs will be paid for by the Dunbar Oaks Neighborhood Association. City crews will install the signs on existing poles. Department of Public Works does not have any issues with this request as long as the signs are funded by others.

B. [ID#17-1069](#) Extend the existing 2 Hour Parking, 8AM to 4PM, on the northeast side of Madison Street to be from 120 feet northwest of the corner of Delafield Street to 110 feet southeast of center of Randall Street.

Recommendation: This item was requested by the Department of Public Works and PD. An existing 2 hour parking zone is placed on the northeast side of Madison Street between Delafield Street and Randall Street. This parking zone ends approximately 80 feet east of corner of Randall Street. The request is to extend the 2 hr parking zone further west to close the gap which is preferred by the parking agents. Department of Public Works does not see any issues with extending this parking zone.

- C. [ID#17-1070](#) Establish No Parking Any Time on the northeast side of Madison Street from 110 feet southeast of the center of Randall Street to 130 feet west of center of Spring Street.

Recommendation: Upon review of the previous item (ID#17-1069), a discrepancy in the parking zone was discovered on the northeast side of Madison Street resulting in a gap in restricted parking. For safety reasons, parking should not be allowed on the northeast side of Madison Street from Randall Street to Spring Street. This item, if approved, will resolve the discrepancy and fully install No Parking Any Time on the northeast side of Madison Street from Randall to Spring.
