- 8. Matter of Report

Director Damien gave an update to the Board on leaf pick-up progress. He stated the crews are at mid-point. The leaf totals brought in to date are 1800 loads. The normal for

the season is 3500. We're on task to have approximately half the loads delivered since the change to not schedule dates. The fuel savings alone saved 3700 gallons worth of fuel because of the changes and not having to go back and redo areas. Crews are working hard and their work is greatly appreciated. We are looking at changes in mapping and tools for next year. Overall it has been a positive change. The crews have collected the same amount of leaves with a few less weeks and other savings and the ability to have some staff able to do emergency work such as the sink hole on Lincoln Ave. Ald. Pieper talked to Park Rec group and the feedback split. Ald. Pieper recommended adding more signage in the neighborhoods so residents know when they'll be in the neighborhood.

Director Damien also reported that the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT) has a large project coming to the City of Waukesha in early 2025. The limits are Sunset up to HWY59. The busiest part of the Bypass. The project will have multiple pavement replacements and traffic signals, and intersection changes by Woodman's. People on the route should have been given notice from the DOT.
