I hereby appeal the decision of the City Planner. I believe the City Planner has incorrectly interpreted Section _____ of the Waukesha Sign Code.



Sign Appeals and Variances Statement

ProHealth Care (PHC) and Eppstein Uhen Architects (EUA) respectfully request a variance to the City of Waukesha Sign Code in the form of two monument signs on the property in support of the proposed new Medical Clinic.

The clinic will provide both primary care and urgent care for patients. Having monument signage easily visible from the street provides the opportunity for PHC to display whether the urgent care portion of the clinic is open or closed. For patients in need of time-sensitive care and approaching the site, this signage is a critical confirmation that they can be seen at this facility.

This site fronts both Sunset Drive and Spring City Street. PHC is requesting a monument sign be provided at both the south side of the building (visible along Sunset Drive) and at the north end of the property (the entry to the parking lot from Spring City Street). It is anticipated that most traffic will approach the site via Sunset Drive. Those arriving from this direction will see the monument sign located south of the building and be able to confirm the open/closed status of the facility. However, there may be others who arrive at this site from the north and therefore bypass Sunset Drive. Having a second monument sign along Spring City Street will signal to these patients as to the status of urgent care.

The proposed signage design is included with this submission for awareness.
