BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin that the Board of Public Works in conformity with Chapter 349 Wisconsin Statutes shall place the following official trafficsigns and signals at the intersections and upon the highways indicated; that said signs and signals shall be so located as to give adequate warning to users of the highway and no provision of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Waukesha, with respect thereto, shall be enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

The following resolution was approved at the September 30, 2024, Building and Grounds meeting and brought forward to the October 15, 2024, Common Council Meeting for approval under the Consent Agenda.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.

- ID#24-10748 Install a stop sign for Overton Avenue at Madison Street.
- ID#24-10749 Install a stop sign for Overton Avenue at Fiddlers Creek Drive.
- ID#24-10750 Install signs in the city owned parking lot northwest of City Hall for "City Hall Visitor Parking Only.".
- ID#24-10751 Install signs in the city owned parking lot northeast of City Hall to be reserved for "City Hall Contractors and Authorized City of Waukesha Vehicles Only."
- ID#24-10752 Install signs in the city owned parking lots adjacent to City Hall for no overnight parking.
- ID#24-10753 Install a speed feedback sign for westbound East Moreland Boulevard around Highland Avenue.
- ID#24-10756 Install two "Caution Children with Disabilities Area" signs on northbound and southbound Bay Berry Drive for the family at 3609 Bay Berry Drive.
- ID#24-10757– Establish a loading zone on the east side of Martin Street in front of St. Joseph's Church Gymnasium doors and extend the existing 2-hour parking zone up to the southern limit of the newly established loading zone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall file this resolution in their office as part of the original City records.
