Awards Presented at the WCMA Annual Conference

At the 10th Annual Wisconsin City/County Management Association (WCMA) Award presentation, three awards were presented to members: Meritorious Service, Futures and Outstanding Program. The Awards Program was developed to honor and acknowledge an outstanding individuals achievement in local government management in Wisconsin.

The Meritorious Service Award was presented to Ed Henschel, City Administrator of Waukesha.

Mr. Henschel has been a part of WCMA for over 30 years. In addition to Waukesha, he has served as a municipal manager in Elm Grove and Whitefish Bay. Ed has also worked as a municipal consultant.

In his desire to nurture the profession and train future municipal managers, he has served as an adjunct Professor for University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee's MPA program and on the Northern Illinois University's MPA Advisory Board.

In his municipal manager capacity in the metro-Milwaukee area, he was involved in negotiating a resolution to a decade long "Sewer Wars" between the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District and nine outlying suburbs. In Waukesha, he is now negotiating with lakefront communities for access to Lake Michigan water. He was integral in the start-up of the North Shore Fire Department consolidation involving seven municipalities. He also was involved in creating a municipal computer consortium involving ten municipalities to reduce hardware and software costs.

For 11 years, Ed was WCMA's Executive Director.
