Thank you for the email request for a sewer credit. The sewer use credit can only be used one time so at a minimum, the credit should not be calculated until the time the extra usage for watering the lawn is complete. In order to calculate a credit, a usage history is needed. If you have just moved in and immediately started watering your lawn, there is no "normal" usage for comparison. Also, usage varies over different periods of time / seasons. I will be looking into your usage history to determine when a credit can be issued and let you know. Thanks,
