Discussion and Recommendation: Establish 2 Hour Parking, 6am to 4pm, Except Saturday Sunday Holiday on the east side of Perkins Avenue from 300 feet south of corner of E. Main Street to the corner of National Avenue.

Details:

Referral was made by Public Works and Ald. Chris Hernandez. This item is to establish a 2 hour parking zone on Perkins Avenue. Existing parking regulations in this area are old and no longer required since the large manufacturing building is empty. The committee discussed this item and voted unanimously to approve it.

Options & Alternatives:

Discuss whether it is appropriate to install this 2 hour parking zone. The reason to establish this zone is to match other street parking zones on Perkins and National Avenue.

Financial Remarks:

The cost of installing approximately 4 new parking signs with new post (new ones) is expected to be \$200 and covered by the BG Sign Budget (3310.54140). The existing signs are not consistent with the proposed zone, very faded and need to be removed.

Executive Action:

The resolution for this installation of this sign assembly will need to be executed by the Mayor and Clerk after the Council Meeting

Committee Recommendation:

The Buildings and Grounds Committee approved this item at their April 20, 2015 meeting. This item will be under the May 5, 2015 Common Council consent agenda.
