CLEAN WATER PLANT

- Submitted DNR monthly Discharge Monitoring Report for May.
- DNR Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR) for 2022 operating year submitted with straight "A"s seven years in a row.
- Change order granted by BPW extending construction deadline for Return Flow Pump station due to delay in pipeline construction.
- Cost analysis update meeting held with Engineer for Phase III Facility Plan design of Biogas.
- Reportable SSO occurred June 23 in force main along Pewaukee Road.
- Loader operator safety training held for staff.
- Continued in-person notifications to restaurants about our new grease ordinance.
- Responded to multiple power outages at plant and lift stations on 6/25.

TRANSIT

- Re-designed service that took effect on June 4th is working well overall.
- Working on minor adjustments to School Service for the 2023-34 school year that were recently approved that will better serve the students and create more efficiencies.
- Riders can use the WisGO cards and app on Route 1 now and Metro routes and bus stops are now available on the WisGO App Trip Planner. Staff is working with UMO on a proposed new fare structure and other items related to fully move to the WisGO fare payment system. New WisGo smartcards are on order. Target is to implement the full system this Fall. The plan is to include Metrolift (paratransit) fares as well.
- Staff is working to implement the Optibus Operations platform with a scheduled launch of late August.
