Banting Elementary School, 2019 Butler Drive- Sign Variance: Request a sign variance to allow an Electronic Message Center on a sign in the I-1, Institutional District

Details:

The applicant is looking for a variance to allow for an Electronic Message Center (EMC) monument sign. The site is zoned I-1 Institutional, which currently does not allow EMC signs. The double-sided monument sign will be approximately 6 feet tall and 5 feet wide, with an overall sign area of 30 S.F. The EMC will be 29"x63". The base of the monument sign will be made from stone.

The applicant is applying for a variance to update their outdated and faded sign. The Electronic Message Center will allow the school to provide up-to-the-minute messages for families of the school. The sign will be located on the south corner of the property on Butler Drive. There are residential properties across the street, however, city sign code requires EMC signs to lower the nits from 3,000 during the day to 500 nits in luminance at sunset. There are several schools and churches in the I-1 zone that have received a variance to allow for an EMC sign.
