A. [ID#16-495](#) Approval to upgrade We Energy lighting at the intersection of Cambridge Ave. and Erin Lane.

Recommendation: Referral was made by Ald. Payne. Local residents have been requesting an increase in lighting at this intersection. At the April 4th B&G meeting, this item was discussed briefly and placed on hold for the April 18th meeting. We were unable to connect with WE Energies to get a recommendation and cost for better lighting here. The item will be placed on hold until May 2nd meeting and we will share WE Energies findings.

Legislative History

B. [ID#16-0608](#) Approve No Trucking Over 3 Ton on N. Greenfield Ave. from E. Broadway to Arcadian Ave.

Recommendation: Residents have seen semi trucks traveling southbound (primarily) and northbound on N. Greenfield Avenue from Arcadian Ave to E. Broadway. There should be no reason for semi trucks to use this street. One block east, Perkins Avenue, Fredrick Street and Pearl Street are designated as trucking routes to get to and from Les Paul Parkway. Currently, N. Greenfield Ave from Racine to E. Broadway and from Arcadian Avenue to E. Main Street has 3 ton weight limits established. The section of N. Greenfield Ave from E. Broadway to Arcadian Ave does not have any restrictions. This request is to establish a 3 ton weight limit on N. Greenfield Ave. from E. Broadway to Arcadian Ave. Staff recommends approval of this request.

- C. [ID#16-0609](#) Approve No Parking Any Time on the west side of White Rock Avenue from the north corner of Niagara Street to E. Moreland Blvd.

Recommendation: Referral was made by Public Works. The impending reconstruction of E. Moreland Blvd. from the Fox River bridge to Manhattan Drive will require reconstruction of the White Rock intersection. The reconstruction will realign lanes on the southern leg of White Rock Avenue and will extend down to Niagara Street. Parking on the west side of White Rock Ave will need to be restricted with the new lane alignment. The change is to have No Parking Any Time on the west side of White Rock Avenue from the north corner of Niagara Street to E. Moreland Blvd. Public Works staff recommends approval of this item.
