A Bidder's Prequalification Statement must be filed with the City of Waukesha at least five (5) calendar days before the Bid opening date. If the contractor's current prequalification on record with the City of Waukesha does not pertain to the specific type of work in this specification, a new Prequalification must be filed. To check the status of Contractor's prequalification, please call (262)524-3600.

A list of all subcontractors must be submitted and approved by the Director of Public Works one (1) calendar day prior to the Board of Public Works meeting scheduled to be held **February 8, 2018**.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Deposit in the form of a Bid Bond or certified check payable to the City of Waukesha in the amount of 5% of the Bid.

Portions of the contract awarded under this invitation for bids may be funded in part by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Safe Drinking Water Loan Program. Neither State of Wisconsin nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is, or will be, party to this invitation to bids or any resulting associated contract.

This procedure is subject to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Safe Drinking Water Loan Program's policy regarding the increased use of disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs). DBEs include, but are not limited to, minority and women businesses. The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Safe Drinking Water Loan Program policy requires all bidders to undertake specified good faith efforts. To comply with the requirements, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Safe Drinking Water Loan Program requires documentation on the contract forms included in the bidding documents, or provide a copy of their bid advertisement. The contract forms, or advertisement copy, **must** be submitted with the bid.

Bids may be withdrawn only pursuant to relevant provisions of Wisconsin law. Otherwise all Bids must be offered for a period extending sixty (60) days beyond the Bid opening.

The portion of this contract for the water main construction is subject to the wage rates established by the State of Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development and the Federal Davis Bacon (DBA) which are included in the bidding documents.

Prevailing wage rates for all trades and occupations involved in the work outside of the water main work shall be in accordance with Sec. 66.0903, Wisconsin Statutes and are included in the bidding documents.

The portion of this contract for the water main construction may be financed in whole, or in part, under H.R 3547, the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014, and is required to use American iron and steel. For purposes of this project this requirement is called the "Use of American Iron and Steel Requirement."

The letting of the work described herein is subject to the provisions of Sec. 62.15, 66.0901, 779.14, 779.15, Wisconsin Statutes, and all other relevant provisions of federal, state and local law.

The City of Waukesha reserves the right to reject any and all Bids.
