<b>Subject:</b> Review and act on the two-party State Municipal Agreement between the City of Waukesha and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the E. Moreland Blvd Bridge project, WisDOT Project ID: 2718-00-78.	

**Details:**  
In 2021, the City of Waukesha applied for Local Bridge Surface Transportation Program funding for the rehabilitation of the E. Moreland Blvd. bridge, B-64-0205 (EB Direction only). In 2022, the City was informed that the applied for funding was awarded for the bridge rehabilitation, and the attached agreement with WisDOT is required for project funding and construction. The project is currently scheduled for 2024 construction.

The bridge rehabilitation project has an estimated total cost of \$452,000 for design and construction and contains an 80% Federal and State/20% Local cost share breakdown of eligible project costs. Within the State/Municipal Agreement, the total City cost responsibility would be \$110,400, which will be included in the 2023 and 2024 CIP budgets.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
Not approving the agreement at this time would mean giving up awarded aid funding for the bridge rehabilitation work.

**Financial Remarks:**  
The local cost share of the project as stated above is estimated to be \$110,400.00.

**Executive Recommendation:**  
Recommend approval of the State Municipal Agreement between the City of Waukesha and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the E. Moreland Blvd Bridge project, WisDOT Project ID: 2718-00-78.
