**Subject:**

NOTE: Items 16-111, 16-112 and 16-113 are all related to the same two city streets, Summit Avenue and Delafield Street. Summit Avenue and Delafield Street will be reconstructed in 2016 and, as a result, existing parking zones will be rescinded and new parking zones established.

Item 16-112. Approve installation of No Parking Any Time at the following locations on Summit Avenue:

1. South side of Summit Avenue from 100 feet west to 50 feet east of N. Cumberland Drive
2. South side of Summit Avenue from 100 feet west to 100 feet east of N. Hine Avenue
3. South side of Summit Avenue from 100 feet west to 100 feet east of N. Washington Avenue
4. South side of Summit Ave from 80 feet west of Hyde Park Ave to 400 feet southeast of Spring Street
5. North side of Summit Avenue from 100 feet west to 80 feet east of N. Cumberland Drive
6. North side of Summit Avenue from 90 feet west to 110 feet east of N. Hine Avenue
7. North side of Summit Avenue from 100 feet west to 120 feet east of N. Washington Avenue
8. North side of Summit Avenue from 80 feet west to 80 feet east of Hyde Park Avenue
9. North side of Summit Avenue from 275 feet west of Spring Street to 400 feet southeast of Spring Street

**Details:**

Referral was made by Public Works, Ald. Payne. The City will be reconstructing Summit Avenue from Moreland Blvd. to Spring Street and Delafield Street from Spring Street to Madison Street. The street has been redesigned and existing parking zones will not be applicable to the new design. Therefore, existing parking zones will need to be rescinded and new parking zones established.

This item covers approving new No Parking zones Summit Avenue.

The new parking zones will not go into affect until after the completion of construction in November of 2016.

The committee considered and reviewed these parking zones and unanimously approved them.

**Financial Remarks:**

Proposed signing installations related to approving the new parking zones will be done by the City Garage and cost for the signs are covered under the Summit Avenue construction project, City budget number 2005.68290
