Details:
6/14/2021. This item was brought forward from Ald. Moltzan to have staff review the crosswalk safety issues at the intersection of N. East Avenue and Wright Street. Staff is presenting this item to the Committee to inform them of an impending study. Any changes to traffic control or lighting will be subject to approval, at a later date, by this Committee.

6/6/2022. Engineering staff have finished their study along East Avenue from the Bike Trail to College Avenue. They will present findings to the committee.

Financial Remarks:
The cost of upgrading the lighting at the mid-block crossing, upgrading the lighting at Wright Street, and installing a new light at McCall Street would be around \$250 and covered by the 2022 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140). The changing of the light pole and upgrading the lighting at the Bike Trail will be covered by the Department of Public Works.
