Details: <p>The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as filling of a swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Mark Dropp, 518 Rempe Dr, requested a credit for sewer service charges for fall of 2023 for an outside faucet the was left on and drained to the yard. Estimated Additional Usage: 17,872 gallons (2023) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$187.30Tom Theisen, 934 River Park Dr, requested a credit for sewer service charges for winter of 2023 for a defective outside faucet that drained to the yard. Estimated Additional Usage: 73,884 gallons (2023) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$774.30Glenn Smiley, 1610 Rockridge Dr, requested a credit for sewer service charges for winter of 2023 for a defective outside faucet that drained to the yard. Estimated Additional Usage: 10,428 gallons (2023) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$109.29
