



Dear Mr. Meredith:

On March 9, 2016, the City of Waukesha Plan Commission reviewed the request for site plan and architectural review of a proposed addition to and the façade upgrade of the Culvers store at 840 W. Sunset Drive. After careful consideration the Commission granted preliminary approval of the plans with the following conditions:

- All Engineering Dept., Water Utility and Fire Dept. comments and notes must be addressed. A copy of their comments is included for your review.
- Stone veneer should be carried along the base of the entire building and all corners should be treated with the stone columns for complete four sided architecture.
- Any roof top mechanicals extending above the parapet are to be screened appropriately to at least the height of the unit. Please show on the elevations.

Engineer Dept. Comments:

1. The following items should be submitted:



- a. Applicable fees per Chapter 32.07(b). The Engineering Division requires any Bonds or Agreements required by the Plan Commission and Council or Chapter 32.08(c). Development fees will be owed to the City for this project.
- b. Chapter 32.07(b)(2): Once all submittal items are completed, submit all items listed in sub.(b)(1)(A)-(G) in digital form for City filing.
- c. Sanitary Sewer Lateral Video
 - i. The existing building has a sanitary sewer lateral connecting the City's sewer main. Please provide a sewer lateral video to City for review and approval. Contact the City Engineering Department for the video format. If lateral maintenance is needed, then the lateral improvements may need to be included as part of this project. The lateral pipe and connection to the main may need to be lined or relayed to reduce infiltration into the City's sanitary sewer system or improve the structural integrity.
- 2. Permits will be needed for the project. Provide copies of approved project permits to the City for filing. Needed permits include but are not limited to:
 - a. City of Waukesha Storm Water Permit.
 - b. Private sanitary sewer approval.

Water Utility Comments:

• Records indicate the water service to the building is 1½ copper.

Fire Dept. Comments:

No concerns noted.
