## Subject:

Review and act on Cemetery Directors request to proceed with building sanitation and records storage.

#### Details:

As of my (Lee Kelley) hire date as Cemetery Director on 2/1/21 it was observed after a thorough inspection that the Prairie Home Cemetery Administration/Chapel building was entirely infested with mice and other rodents. A professional cleaning sanitation company (Steri-Clean) inspected the building and found that the cemetery carpet, furniture, desks, file cabinets, attic, basement and chapel were all contaminated with mice droppings and urine. In the attic larger droppings were identified. (Safe Way Pest Control and Steri-Clean) found that multiple travel tunnels for the mice throughout the building. Please see quote below to address these issues.

- Storage Unit/Mobile Mini \$656.21Reocurring monthly fee of \$134.62
- Record Removal/Steri-clean \$3,660.00
- Sanitizing Building/Steri-clean \$4,060.00
