Whereas, the City of Waukesha Police Department entered into a cooperative agreement with the United States Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") on February 21, 2022 to have a Waukesha officer assigned to the North Central High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Task Force; and
Whereas , the federal government will grant funds to support the City's participation in the HIDTA Task Force, including funds to provide a vehicle for the use of the officer assigned by the City to the Task Force; and
Whereas the most economical means to provide a vehicle for the officer's use is by a lease, and provided the City enters into a formal lease agreement for a vehicle, HIDTA will reimburse the City for the cost of a leased vehicle up to \$6,000; and
Whereas, Andrew Motor Sales, Inc., is willing to enter into a lease agreement with the City in the form of the attached exhibit, provided the Common Council passes a resolution approving the lease and authorizing its execution by appropriate City officials;
Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha that the attached lease agreement with Andrew Motor Sales, Inc. is approved, and the Mayor and City Clerk-Treasurer are authorized and directed to execute it along with any other documentation necessary to complete the transaction.
