Subject: Review and act on the Contract extension with United Liquid Waste for bio-solids hauling for the City's Clean Water Plant.	

Details:
United Liquid Waste has offered a contract extension for hauling of bio-solids for the City's Clean Water Plant. They would hold the 2023 rate at \$27.50 per ton, should the City decide to exercise that option. United Liquid Waste has been contracted with the City for the last 12 years and has done a satisfactory job and is familiar with our processes and requirements. The current contract was started in 2023.

Options & Alternatives:
The contract has an option to renew at their request. The City may re-bid the contract. Re-bidding may result in a higher price. The overall CPI for transportation increased 2.9% from December 2023 to 2024. Based on this, we believe re-bidding would result in higher costs for sludge hauling.

Financial Remarks:
Sludge disposal is charged to account number 7388.53910 which has \$165,000 budgeted for 2024. The City paid United Liquid Waste \$159,722 in 2023 for bio-solids hauling.

Executive Recommendation:
Recommend approval of the contract extension with United Liquid Waste for bio-solids hauling for the City's Clean Water Plant at \$27.50 per ton.
