3. Discussion and Recommendation re:

A. ID#15-2384 Install two stop signs on Fox River Circle (south) and River Valley Road.

Recommendation: Engineering staff has reviewed the request to install two stop signs on Fox River Circle

(south) at the River Valley Road intersection. Currently, the intersection has no traffic control. There is another intersection of Fox River Circle (north) just to the north and it has stop signs for the east and west approaches to the intersection. Staff recommends

installation of the two stop signs.

Recommended Motion: Move to install two stop signs at the intersection of Fox River Circle (south) and River Valley Road for the eastbound and westbound approaches.

B. ID#15-2385 Rescind all parking zones on the east side of Perkins Avenue from the

corner E. Main Street to National Avenue.

Recommendation: Upon the request of the parking agents and in coordination with Ald. Hernandez, staff

has review the existing parking zones along the east side of Perkins Avenue from Main Street to National Avenue. There are several existing parking zones that were place years ago when the manufacturing building was full and workers needed to park on Perkins Avenue. The buildings are at a lower use today and the parking zones no longer make since. Existing parking signing has fallen into disrepair and parking

agents find it hard to give tickets.

To that end, engineering staff is recommending removal of all parking zones on the east side of Perkins and to establish new zones that are typical of zones on the rest of Perkins Avenue. This item No. 15-2385 will cover the rescinding of the existing parking

zones and Items No. 15-2386, 2387, 2388 will cover the new parking zones.

Recommended Motion: Move to rescind all parking zones on the east side of Perkins

Avenue from the corner E. Main Street to National Avenue.

business have parking lots.

Recommended Motion: Move to establish 2 Hour Parking, 6am to 4pm, Except Saturday Sunday Holiday on the east side of Perkins Avenue from 300 feet south of

corner of E. Main Street to the corner of National Avenue.

on the terrace that say "Do Not Park on Terrace". The terrace on the east side of Perkins Avenue from E. Main Street to about 400 feet south is paved with asphalt. Parking agents have given out tickets for persons parking their cars on top of the

asphalt terrace.

Recommended Motion: Move to install signs that say Do Not Park on Terrace on east

side of Perkins Avenue from corner of E. Main Street to 400 feet south.

Approve a speed awareness campaign to allow yard type signs in the terrace area on Madison St. from Moreland Blvd. to North St. starting May 16th, 2015 for two weeks.

Recommendation:

Staff has reviewed this request by the Tower Hill Neighborhood group to install "slow down" speed awareness signs in the terrace on Madison Street. This group conducted the campaign in 2014 with permission from Buildings & Grounds and complied with staff requirements. Staff recommends approval of the campaign in 2015 subject to the following conditions:

The Tower Hill Group will be responsible for placement of the signs in the terrace and removal of the signs after the two week period.

The group should also insure that the signs are not given to others that are not in the Tower Hill area as to keep the signs from popping up all over the City. The group may keep the signs displayed on their private property behind the sidewalk.

The group shall conduct all activity safely and in coordination with the City police department.

Recommended Motion: Move to approve a speed awareness campaign to allow yard type signs in the terrace area on Madison St. from Moreland Blvd. to North St. starting May 16th, 2015 for two weeks.
