

PLANTING NOTES:

DCONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY LOCATION OF ALL ON-SITE UTILITIES PRIOR TO COMMENCING ANY WORK ON-SITE. WI STATE STATUTE 182.0175 REQUIRES THREE WORK DAYS NOTICE BEFORE YOU EXCAVATE. CALL

2) Supply and install all Wisconsin grown nursery stock. Guarantee all stock for a period of one year. All planting material is to meet American Standards for Nursery Stock ANSI 260.1-2004. All plant material is to be planted immediately after arrival and unloading on SITE. ${\sf P}$ LANT TYPES, SIZES, AND QUANTITIES ARE ACCORDING TO THE PROPOSED PLANS. IF ANY DISCREPANCIES ARE PRESENT BETWEEN PLANT LEGEND AND GRAPHIC DEPICTION, GRAPHICALLY DEPICTED

 $3) \! A$ CTUAL LOCATIONS OF PLANT MATERIAL ARE SUBJECT TO FINAL SITE LAYOUT AND CONDITIONS AND MAY BE

4) Guy and stake all large trees and evergreens. 5) All plants are to be backfilled with a 50/50 mix of plant starter and topsoil blend and is to be free of roots, rocks larger than 1" in diameter, subsoil debris, and weeds. 6)OPEN AND REMOVE THE TOP BURLAP AND TWINE OR STRING FROM ALL BALLED

AND BURLAPPED PLANTS AND SET ALL PLANTS AT FINISHED GRADE.

7) Supply and install 3-4" of shredded hardwood bark mulch in all planting beds, and 1-11/2" IN ALL PERENNIAL BEDS. TREAT ALL AREAS WITH A PRE-EMERGENT HERBICIDE (GRANULAR FORM) 'TREFLAN' OR APPROVED EQUAL FOLLOWING ALL MANUFACTURER'S WRITTEN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PLACING

8) Supply and install 3-4" of shredded hardwood mulch 1' past the DRIP LINE of all individual TREES. DO NOT PLACE MULCH AGAINST TRUNK OF TREE.

9) Supply and install black vinyl edging 'Ace of Diamond' manufactured by V alleyview Industries OR APPROVED EQUAL IN ALL PLANTING BEDS THAT ADJOIN TURE AREAS ACCORDING TO THE MANUFACTURER'S

10)ALL TURF AREAS ARE TO BE FINE-GRADED. ALL TURF AREAS ARE TO BE SEEDED, AREAS ARE TO BE SOWN AT THE MANUFACTURER'S RECOMMENDED RATES AND COVERED WITH A CLEAN OAT STRAW. TURF AREAS ARE TO BE SOWN WITH NELSON LANDSCAPE'S CUSTOM BLENDED SEED FOR LAWNS AND IS TO BE APPLIED AT THE RECOMMENDED RATE, A STARTER FERTILIZER APPLIED, AND COVERED WITH A CLEAN OAT STRAW. ANY AREAS WHERE POTENTIAL EROSION EXISTS DUE TO WIND OR WATER OR OTHER MEANS INCLUDING ALL SLOPES OF 3:1 OR GREATER SHALL BE COVERED WITH STRAW EROSION CONTROL BLANKETS 'DS-75' MANUFACTURED BY NORTH AMERICAN GREEN, INSTALLED TO MANUFACTURER'S WRITTEN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS.

BIO-RETENTION AREA(S) PLANTING:

DALL PLANT PLUGS SHALL BE IN HEALTHY, VIGOROUS GROWING CONDITION AND SHALL HAVE WELL DEVELOPED ROOT SYSTEMS AND BE NURSERY GROWN BY A GROWER SPECIALIZING IN THE GROWING OF NATIVE PLANTS. 2)ALL BIO-SWALES SHALL BE COVERED WITH STRAW EROSION CONTROL BLANKETS 'DS-75' OR EQUAL MANUFACTURED BY NORTH AMERICAN GREEN TO PREVENT WIND AND WATER EROSION DURING NATIVE PLANT ESTABLISHMENT.

3)PLANT PLUGS SHALL BE INSTALLED WITH CARE INTO EXISTING STRAW EROSION CONTROL BLANKETS, AVOIDING ANY UNECESSARY COMPACTION OF ENGINEERED SOIL AND INFILTRATION SYSTEM. 4)A LAYER OF SHREDDED HARDWOOD BARK MULCH SHALL BE PLACED TO HELP PREVENT WEED GROWTH TO A DEPTH OF 1". 5)PLANT PLUGS TO ENSURE THE CROWN OF THE PLANT IS LEVEL WITH THE EXISTING FINAL GRADE, DO NOT

BURY OR PILE MULCH AGAINST THE NEW PLANTS. 6)WATER ALL PLANTS IMMEDIATELY AFTER PLANTING AND CONTINUE TO WATER THROUGHOUT THE FIRST GROWING SEASON AS NEEDE TO ENSURE PLANTS RECIEVE 11/2" OF WATER PER WEEK DURING ESTABLISHMENT 7) MAINTAIN ALL BIO-SWALES THROUGHOUT THE FIRST GROWING SEASON AS NECESSARY WHICH MAY INCLUDE PERIODIC WEEDING BY HAND UNTIL PLANTS BECOME ESTABLISHED.
