Eagle Scout Project

- Plan
- Develop
- Leadership to Others in a service project helpful to any religious institution, school or community.

Planning

- Starts with a meeting with the product beneficiary, decide on a project
- Scout has clear understanding of your expectations and limitations
- Proposal must be approved by the BSA local council

Develop

- Develop a plan for implementing the project, beneficiary approves final project
- Look into permits, permissions, authorizations, funding, supervision and safety
- Develop a timeline and schedule to get the project completed

Leadership

- Scout must provide the leadership necessary for the project completion
- Must be able to organize people and assign tasks
- Troubleshoot any unexpected problems

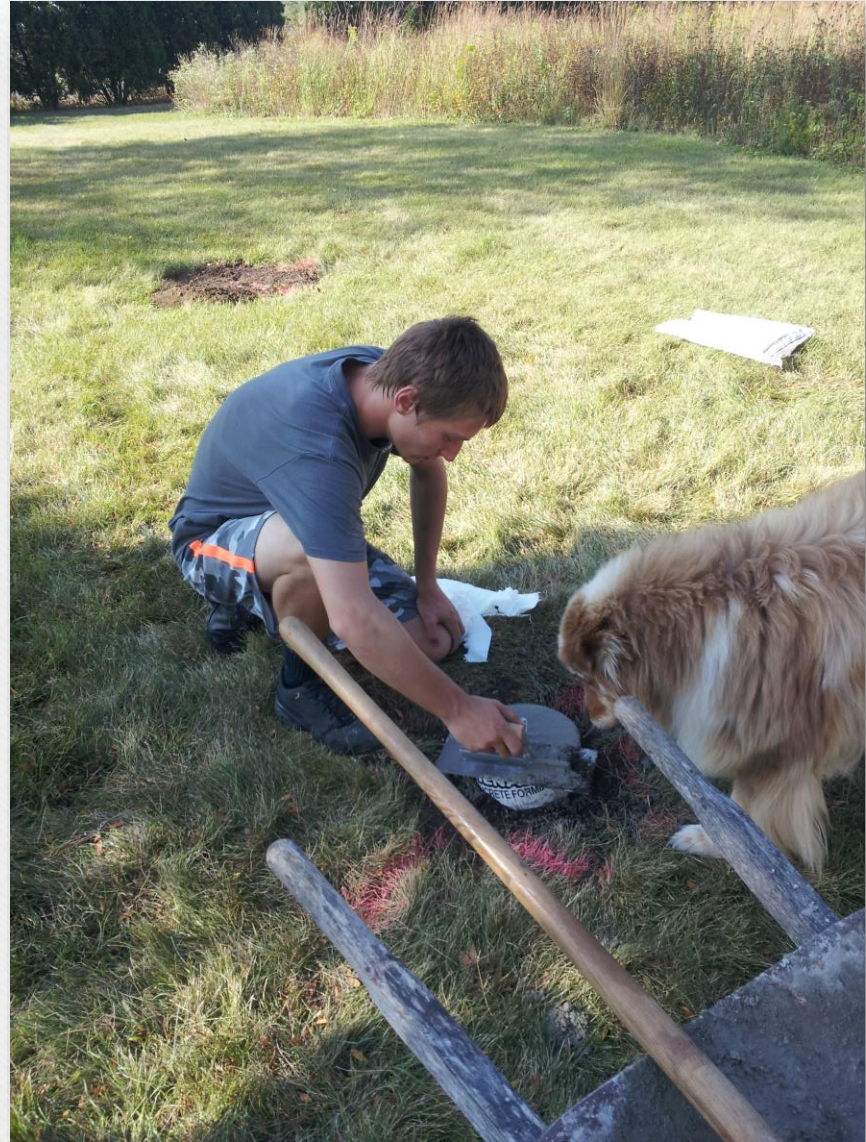
