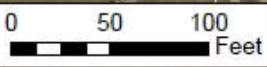

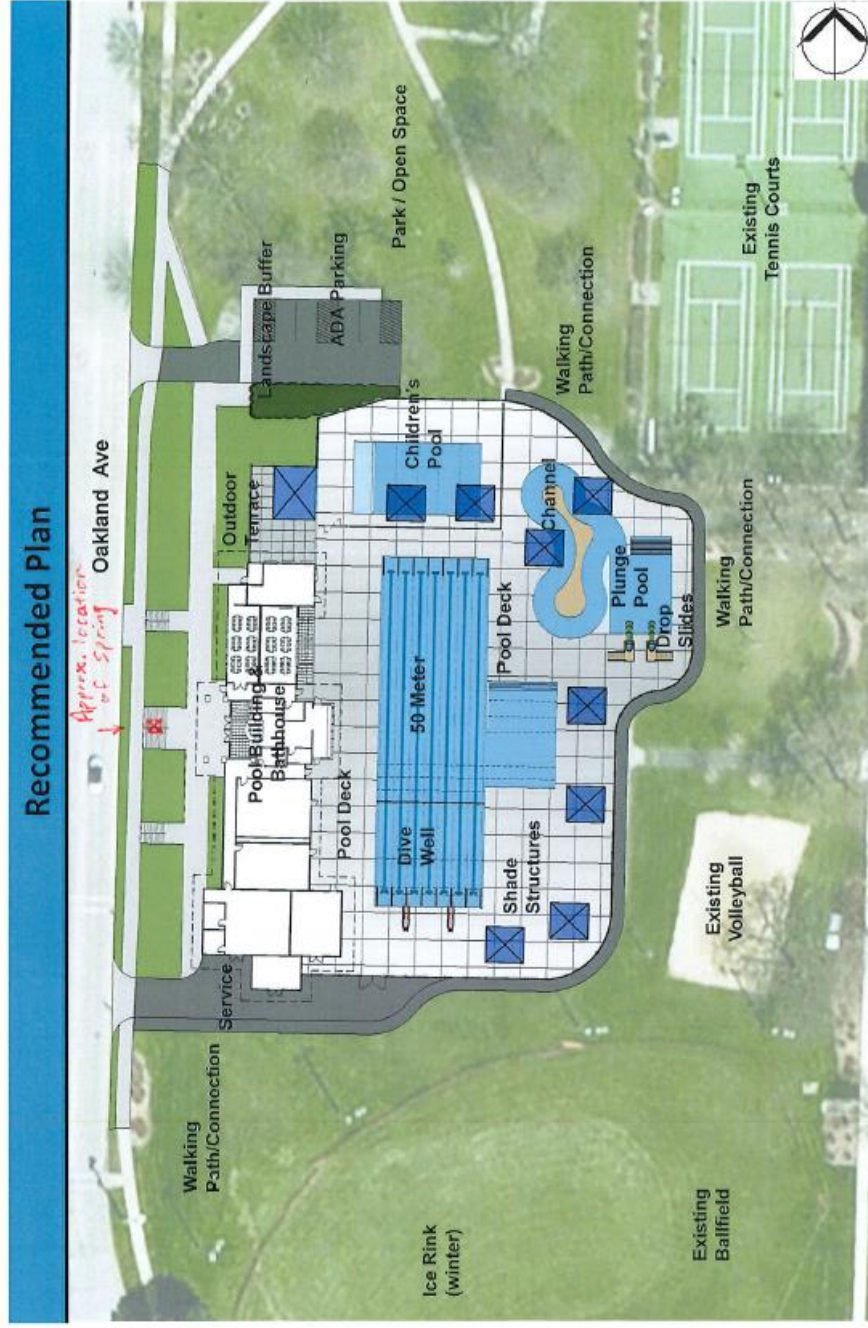

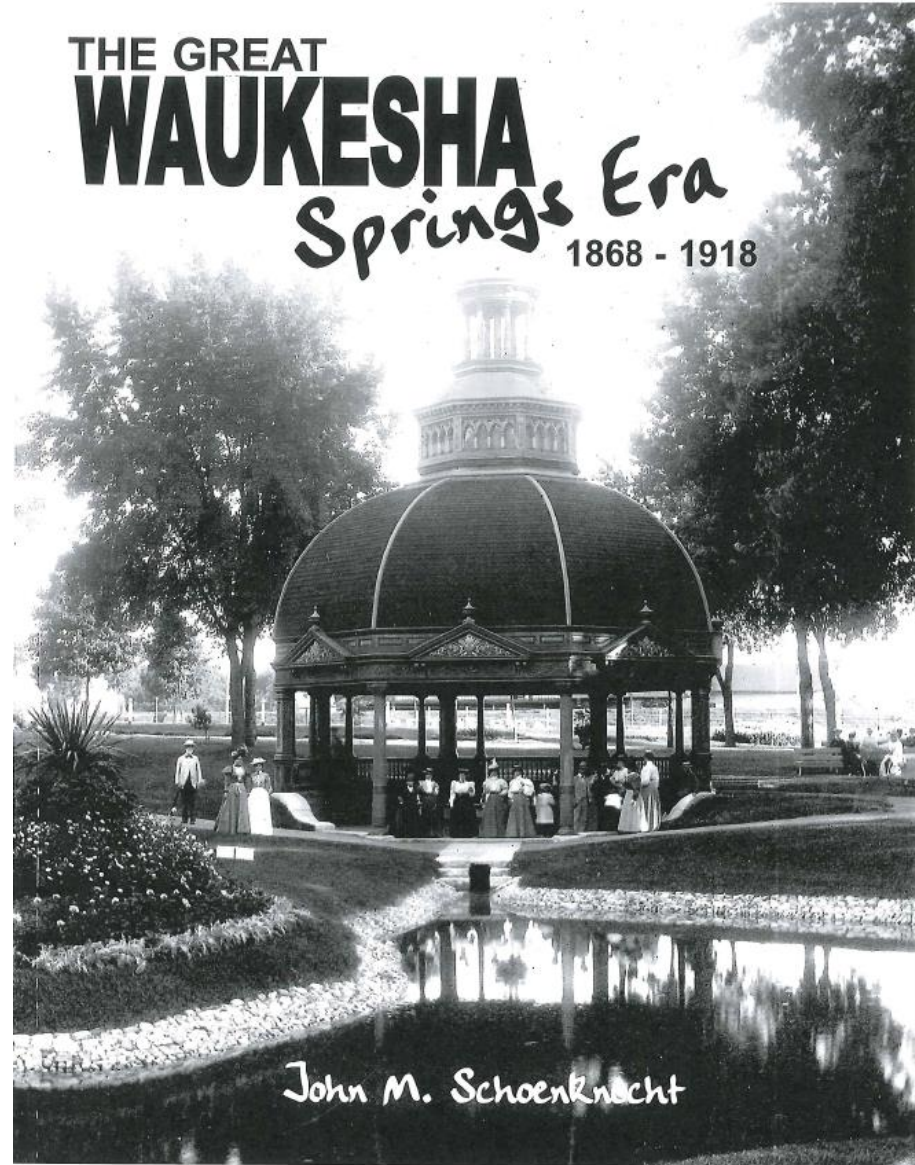
John Paul Buchner, 1835-1923.

John P. Buchner:

- Born 1835 in Bavaria.
- Immigrated with family to the U.S. at 5 years old.
- Made his fortune in the California Gold Rush.
- Moved to Waukesha from New Berlin in 1877.
- Donated the land for Buchner Park in 1915 and after his death in 1923.
- Park development began in 1927.

Designation Criteria:

A landmark, landmark site, or historic district designation may be placed on any site or area which fulfills one or more of the following criteria:

- a) Exemplifies or reflects the broad cultural, political, natural, economic, or social history of the City of Waukesha, State, or Nation.
- b) Is identified with historic personages or with important events in National, State, or local history.
- c) Embodies the distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type inherently valuable for study of a period, style, construction method, or of indigenous materials or craftsmanship.
- d) Is representative of notable work of a master builder, designer, or architect whose individual genius influences an era.
