ID#15-2998 Approve installation of "Deaf Child Area" signs on the 1100 block of

Wisteria Lane.

Recommendation: Staff has reviewed this request to install "Deaf Child Area" warning signs on Wisteria

Lane. The petitioner is located at 1147 Wisteria Lane. The resident is concerned with

eastbound traffic coming off of Oakdale. The best location for signs would be

eastbound Wisteria Lane west of Cottonwood near the alley and westbound near 1134

Wisteria. Staff supports the installation of these signs.

Recommended Motion: Move to approve installation of Deaf Child Area warning signs on eastbound Wisteria Lane, west of Alley 90 and on westbound Wisteria Lane at the

eastern property line of 1134 Wisteria Lane.

<u>ID#15-2999</u> Remove the "No Parking" signs on Pebble Valley Road near Woodburn

Road, directly across from 2505-2507 Pebble Valley Road.

Recommendation: Staff has reviewed this request and recommends to keep the existing no parking signs

on the west side of Pebble Valley Road near 2505. The petitioners have requested this No Parking zone to be removed to allow for family members to park closer to the 2050 / 2507 Pebble Valley property. The parking zone that exists on the west side of Pebble Valley from Hunting Ridge to 150 feet north is there because of the bus stop at Hunting Ridge. The No Parking zone allows for busses to pull up to the curb without having a parked car in the way. Also, there is no guarantee that removing or adjusting the zone will provide available parking for specific people, others can park there as well. Staff

recommends no action on this item.
