<b>Subject:</b> Review and Discuss Cemetery's 2024 CIP Camera Requests	

**Details:**  
For safety and security reasons, security cameras are requested at Prairie Home Cemetery. The cameras will help to enhance the safety and security of all staff and visitors, deter undesirable behavior, and help to identify causes of issues that may arise. Examples of issues that have occurred in the past are graffiti, theft, illegal dumping, and crashes near the cemetery entrances.

The attached quote from BAYCOM includes eight cameras and connection equipment. Four of the cameras are for the chapel building entrances, and four cameras are for the cemetery grounds.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
If all the cameras cannot be approved, cameras and connection equipment for both entrances and the chapel overview are top priority.

**Financial Remarks:**  
This request is part of the CIP for 2024 consideration. The total for the cemetery cameras is \$47,686.65.

**Executive Recommendation:**  
Recommend approval of funding for cameras at Prairie Home Cemetery.
