Please approve new/updated Parking Zones along the southwest side of W. Broadway from N. Barstow Street to Wisconsin Avenue as a result of the Broadway reconstruction project.

Details:

7/31/2023. With W. Broadway being reconstructed from N. Barstow Street to Wisconsin Avenue, modifications to the existing "No Parking, Loading Zone" along with appropriately signing the new on-street, parallel parking spots on the southwest side of W. Broadway are necessary.

- Modify the "No Parking, Loading Zone" on the southwest side of W. Broadway from 162 feet east of N. Barstow Street to 115 feet east of N. Barstow Street.
- Establish "No Parking Carryout Zone 10 Minutes Only This Stall except Sundays" for the parking stall in front of 139 W. Broadway.
- Establish "2-Hr Parking 7AM-7PM except Sundays and Holidays" on the southwest side of W. Broadway from 175 feet east of N. Barstow Street to 285 feet east of N. Barstow Street.
