Subject:

Review and approve updated Residential Garbage and Recycling Regulations.

Details:

The City's current residential refuse and recycling contract is set to expire on March 28, 2025. The City is entering a new contract effective March 31, 2025, with a new contractor, Johns Disposal

In conjunction with the transition of contracts, the City needs to update the Residential Recycling and Solid Waste Regulations, which are empowered by City Code 13.055, and provide detailed instructions to residents regarding specific recycling and garbage related topics.

Options & Alternatives: None.

Financial Remarks:

Fees included within the regulations are consistent with the City's contractual agreement with Johns Disposal and additionally include considerations for the new City-owned carts for automated pickup.
