**Resolution Approving the 2024 Waukesha Transit Commission  
Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration has published the final rule for Public Transportation Agency Safety Plans as authorized by the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) and the final rule requires States and certain operators of public transportation systems that receive Federal financial assistance under 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 to develop Public Transportation Agency Safety Plans based on the Safety Management System approach, and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration Circular 49 CFR Part 673 provides guidance relating to Federal Transit Administration's Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan requirements for recipients including approval of their Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan by their governing entity and the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law included additional requirements and

**WHEREAS**, changes to the existing Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan are required to remain in compliance and are included in the Waukesha Transit Commission 2024 Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan and

**WHEREAS**, the Waukesha Transit Commission has reviewed the current Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan and identified all revisions necessary for compliance with the revised federal requirements and

**WHEREAS**, the attached "Waukesha Transit Commission 2024 Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan" incorporates those revisions and complies in all respects with the revised federal requirements

**Now, therefore**, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha that:

The Waukesha Transit Commission 2024 Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan be approved and adopted.
