Please approve no parking between the driveways of 2712 Welsh Court and 2710 Welsh Court from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### Details:

12/4/2023. This item was brought forward by City Garage with support from Ald. Bartels to restrict parking at the north side of the Welsh Court cul-de-sac from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup> to ease in salting and snow plowing operations. Engineering staff have reviewed this request and do not have an issue with creating the no parking zone from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>.

The cost for installing two (2) no parking signs and two (2) new sign poles would be around \$140 and covered by the 2023 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140).

#### **Executive Recommendation:**

The Department of Public Works recommends establishing the no parking zone from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup> on the north side of the cul-de-sac of Welsh Court between #2712 and #2710.
