Subject:

Review and act on a request for up to \$40,000 to raze the structures at 204 S. Charles.

Details:

The structures at 204 S. Charles are uninhabitable and structurally compromised causing a public safety hazard. After writing correction orders and raze orders on the property no action was taken. The structures have deteriorated to a point that they pose a serious safety concern to the public. The City is in the process of obtaining a raze order from the court to remove the structures. Once received the City will raze the structures for public safety reasons.

Following completion of the project a special charge will be levied against the property for the cost of the raze.

Options & Alternatives:

Financial Remarks:

The City is in the process of selling the City parking lot at the corner of Clinton St. and Wisconsin Ave. for \$200,000. We propose using a portion of those funds to pay for the cost of the raze.

Executive Recommendation:

Approve the funding and move forward with the removal of the structures.
