WHEREAS, first responders including fire, EMS, law enforcement, public works, transportation and towing services put their safety at risk to assist and save lives, with Waukesha experiencing 1324 crashes resulting in 358 injuries last year; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin aims to protect its first responders, reminding drivers that they have a responsibility to follow the "Move Over Law" to create a safety zone for workers on the side of roadways; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation aims to expand public awareness and knowledge of the dangers facing first responders through education and outreach; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration has set aside a week each year to help further these goals, recognize the tireless efforts of first responders, and remember those who have lost their lives.
