<b>Subject:</b> Review and act on the updated State Municipal Agreement (SMA) with the WisDOT for the N Prairie Avenue bridge project, WisDOT Project ID: 2718-20-70.	

**Details:**  
In 2018, the City of Waukesha entered into a two-party agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) for the Prairie Avenue and Madison Street.

The bid for the Prairie Avenue Bridge project came in over budget and the previous SMA total. The project was originally budgeted at \$182,470.00 and the bid came in at \$251,029.00. The State has received approval to increase the funding to cover the 80% of the new cost. The updated SMA accounts for the additional State/City cost for the project.

All costs for the project will be split 80/20 (State/City) and were budgeted for in the 2020 CIP Budget.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
There were no other alternatives

**Financial Remarks:**  
Originally the City was responsible (20%) for \$36,494.00 in construction costs. With the project coming in over budget the City is now responsible for \$51,862.00 (includes non-participating items). This additional \$15,368 will be paid out of acct #: 0002-68290
