The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as filling a swimming pool or establishing new landscaping.

 Rachel Zuniga, 1805 Deer Trail Ct a one-time credit for sewer service charges for September and October 2024 for establishing new landscaping.

Estimated Additional Usage: 10,638 gallons (2024) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$111.49
