 - A. [ID#19-1241](#) Please approve installation of a Stop sign on Huron Lane at Mohican Trail.
Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Ald. Perry. Residents in the area have requested a stop sign to be installed on Huron Lane at the Mohican Trail intersection. This is a "T" intersection. Public Works does not have any issues with this item. The cost for this signing will be around \$75.

 - B. [ID#19-1242](#) Please approve No Parking Any Time on the south side of E. Sunset Drive from Les Paul Parkway to Guthrie Road.
Recommendation: This item was brought forward by Public Works in preparation for the pavement marking changes that will occur on E. Sunset Drive from Les Paul Parkway to Guthrie Road. The eastbound half of E. Sunset Dr. will be marked with two eastbound lanes and will not allow for any parking on the south side of street. This item is to approve no parking on the south side of E. Sunset Drive from Les Paul Parkway to Guthrie Road. Staff recommends approval. The cost for this signing will be around \$400.

- C. [ID#19-1243](#) Please approve sign installation that reads Right Lane Must Turn Right on eastbound E. Sunset Drive at Guthrie Road.
- Recommendation:** This item was brought forward by Public Works. With the installation of a new pavement marking scheme on E. Sunset Drive from Les Paul Parkway to Guthrie Road, the eastbound direction will have two lanes of traffic. Two lanes will terminate at Guthrie Road and the outside lane will drop off to a right turn only lane. The request is to approve signing that indicated that eastbound right turning traffic must turn right. The cost for this signing will be around \$100.
