Subject: To study whether the intersection of Hoover Avenue and Garfield Avenue should be converted to an all-way stop intersection.	

Details:
11/6/2023. This item was brought forward by Ald. Anderson as a referral to study the intersection of Hoover Avenue and Garfield Avenue to determine if it should change from a two-way stop with Garfield Avenue being stopped to an all-way stop controlled intersection. Engineering staff have reviewed this request and do not support changing the intersection to an all-way stop controlled intersection. Engineering recommends updating the faded pedestrian crossing signs on eastbound and westbound Hoover Avenue at Garfield Avenue to current standards.

Options & Alternatives:
None

Financial Remarks:
The cost for installing four (4) pedestrian crossing signs, two (2) ahead plaques, and two (2) downward left pointing arrow plaques would be around \$400 and covered by the 2023 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140).

Executive Recommendation:
The Department of Public Works recommends the updating the pedestrian crossing signage for eastbound and westbound Hoover Avenue at Garfield Avenue to current standards.
