Ordinance No. ____-19

**An Ordinance Creating Section 6.123 of the Waukesha Municipal Code,
Regarding the Depositing of Snow onto Certain Public and Private Properties**

The Common Council of the City of Waukesha do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 6.123 of the Waukesha Municipal Code is created to read in its entirety as follows:

6.123 Depositing Snow on Certain Public and Private Properties Prohibited.

- (1) No person shall move, or cause to be moved, by any means, snow, slush, or ice, from that person's private property, or any sidewalk, driveway apron, or terrace in the public right-of-way adjacent to that person's private property, onto a public street, parking lot, or sidewalk, and allow it to remain there.
- (2) No person shall move, or cause to be moved, by any means, snow, slush, or ice, from that person's private property, or any sidewalk, driveway apron, or terrace in the public right-of-way adjacent to that person's private property, onto the private property of another, or any sidewalk, driveway apron, or terrace in the public right-of-way adjacent to another's private property, and allow it to remain there, unless the other private property owner has given permission to do so.
- (3) Snow, slush, and ice may be moved from private property, and sidewalks and driveway aprons adjacent to that private property, onto terraces within the public right-of-way adjacent to that private property.

Section 2. Subsection (4) of Municipal Code §6.12 is repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. All ordinances, or portions of ordinances, inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its publication.
