<b>Subject:</b> Please rescind the previously approved (ID #16-1275) of "No Parking at any time on both sides of Walden Circle from the south lot line of 3028 to the south lot line of 3035 Walden Circle".	

**Details:**

This referral was made by Ald. Boyle. As depicted in the subject, residents on Walden Circle objected to having No Parking signs installed and have requested the previously approved No Parking zone (ID#16-1275) be rescinded. The original No Parking zone (ID#16-1275) was requested by the Fire Department to address the issue of emergency response vehicles not be able to make it around Walden Circle and requested an item to be placed on the B&G committee to have No Parking zone approved. This original No Parking zone was approved at the 8-15-16 B&G meeting. Subsequent to that, City Attorney Running made an evaluation and concluded that the City may be held liable in the case of an emergency, knowing that a fire truck cannot make it around the cul de sac. After reviewing Attorney Running's opinion, the engineering staff and the fire department staff work out a different parking zone solution, that we feel, will be better received by the residents on Walden.

This item ID#16-1656 is now recommended to be approved, that is, to rescind the previously approved parking zone. The Buildings & Grounds committee voted to approve item ID#16-1656, 3 aye, 1 nay.
