A Charter Ordinance Repealing Charter Ordinance 52-87, Regarding the Separation of the Offices of Clerk and Treasurer

Whereas Charter Ordinance 52-87, passed by the Common Council on November 5, 1987, consolidated the offices of City Clerk and City Treasurer into one office titled City Clerk-Treasurer; and

Whereas the Common Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City of Waukesha that the positions be separated again;

Now, therefore, the Common Council of the City of Waukesha do ordain as follows:

- **Section 1.** The City of Waukesha elects once again to be governed by the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes §62.09 providing that the City shall have a separate Clerk and Treasurer, and that therefore Charter Ordinance 52-87 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- **Section 2.** The offices of Clerk and Treasurer shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Common Council.
- **Section 3.** Municipal Code §2.01(2) is amended to replace the entry for Clerk-Treasurer with separate entries for Clerk and Treasurer, with appointment by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the Common Council, and indefinite terms.
- **Section 4.** This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 60 days after its passage and publication, unless a petition meeting the requirements of Wisconsin Statutes §66.0101(5) is filed and a referendum is held, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall not take effect unless it is approved by a majority of the electors voting in the referendum.
