Review and Act on Proposed Minor Service Changes Effective November 11, 2024

Details:

This item is to review and act on proposed minor service changes that would be effective November 11, 2024 which includes approval of a resolution modifying Route 2. The proposed routing change would slightly modify how Route 2 serves the Woodman's Food Market. The proposed change is to have Route 2 enter Woodman's from Main St. at the second (western) drive near Planet Fitness instead of currently entering from northern drive from Manhattan Drive. This change would reduce travel distance to the Woodman's bus stop thus saving time. Route 2 would still exit Woodman's from Manhattan Dr.

Another proposed change is to eliminate the bus stops on Route 6 at 1205 S. Grandview Blvd and opposite to 1025 S. Grandview Blvd. Both stops have extremely low ridership and existing stops close to them. In addition, the bus stop opposite to 1205 S. Grandview does not have an ADA pad nor is there sidewalk.

Options & Alternatives:

The alternative would be to reject the proposed changes and leave routing and bus stops as they are currently.

Financial Remarks:

The costs of the changes are minimal and long term there is some savings as there would be two less bus stops to maintain and replace over time.

Executive Recommendation:

Recommend approval.
