Subject: Please approve new/updated Parking Zones along Delafield Street from Lemira Avenue to Magnolia Drive as a result of the Delafield Street reconstruction project.	

Details: 4/3/2023. With Delafield Street being reconstructed from south of Lemira Avenue to north of Magnolia Drive, additional "No Parking" signs are necessary because of pedestrian bump outs being installed to increase pedestrian safety along with providing space for bus stops. The additional "No Parking" signs are being installed to inhibit vehicles from parking alongside the bump outs and provide space to buses for their respective bus stops. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Establish "No Parking" on the west side of Delafield Street 100' north and 50' south of Lemira Avenue.• Establish "No Parking" on the east side of Delafield Street 50' north and 50' south of Lemira Avenue.• Establish "No Parking" on the east side of Delafield Street from 65' south of the north drive to #1001 to 10' north of the north drive to #1001.• Establish "2 Hour Parking 6am to 6pm except Saturday, Sunday, Holiday" on the east side of Delafield Street from 10' north of the north drive to #1001 to 25' south of the drive to #1021.• Establish "No Parking" on the east side of Delafield Street from 25' south of the drive to #1021 to 15' north of the northern crosswalk at the intersection of Delafield Street and Washington Avenue.• Establish "No Parking" on the east side and west side of Delafield Street from W. Moreland Boulevard to 425' north of W. Moreland Boulevard.• Establish "No Parking" on west side of Delafield Street from 220' north and 55' south of W. Washington Avenue.• Establish "No Parking" on the west side of Delafield Street from 145' north and 50' south of Magnolia Drive.
