The City of Waukesha Engineering Division has reviewed the proposed driveways shown on the Meadowview Park – Final Concept plan (Attached). The Engineering Division has the following recommendations:

- Slightly adjust the easterly entrance as shown on the Meadowview Park – Final Concept plan to line up opposite Kayla Drive.
- The westerly driveway as shown on the Meadowview Park – Final Concept plan and on the West Waukesha Bypass plans (Project ID 2788-00-02) is acceptable to Engineering.

The Engineering Division would recommend approval of the 2 driveways with the modifications outlined above.
