Subject: Review and Act on Request to Decommission 2008 Gillig Buses	

Details:
This item is to review and act on the request to decommission three 2008 Gillig Fixed Route Buses (Buses 153, 154, 155). These buses are 3 years past their useful life and are only used for short peak runs. The 2008 buses are roughly 20% less fuel efficient than the rest of the fixed fleet and have much higher emissions. The replacement buses are in production and are scheduled for delivery in early May. The 2008 buses would be sold via bid or direct to another transit system. If a price is not secured at or above the scrap price, the buses will be sold for scrap.

Options & Alternatives:
There are no viable options due to the age and condition of the vehicles.

Financial Remarks:
The estimated sale price is \$2,000-5,000 per bus. The sale proceeds would go to the operating budget of the transit system.
