<b>Subject:</b> Review and act on Proposed Bus Stop Elimination	

**Details:**  
This item is to review and act on proposed bus stop elimination at the northeast corner of Abbott Rd. and Parklawn Dr. The bus shelter at this location would also be eliminated. The reason for this request is with the new June 4<sup>th</sup> routing of Route 1, it is not possible to serve that stop in its current location as the new routing has the bus turning left onto Parklawn instead of going straight on Abbott across to Heritage. Transit looked into moving the stop to the east 100 feet but it would not make sense to do so as it would then be only 500 feet (167 yards) from the bus stop and shelter to the east. Transit will determine if the shelter at the Abbott and Parklawn location can be re-purposed to a new location.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
The only alternative would be to move the bus stop 100 feet to the east but it would only then be 500 feet from the next stop and shelter which is less than half the distance the standard distance of bus stops are spaced.

**Financial Remarks:**  
The removal of the bus stop has minimal labor cost.

**Executive Recommendation:**  
Recommend approval.
