Recommendation: Staff has reviewed this request and has no objections to it. The approximate cost for

installing signs for this parking zone will be \$250. Staff recommends approval.

<u>ID#15-3731</u> Evaluate enhancing the crosswalk with flashing solar signs at the

Waukesha Springs Park crossing on Hartwell Ave and possibly teaming

with Parks and Rec for funding and planning.

Recommendation: Staff has done an initial review of this request. The nature of the request is to install

enhancements to the existing crosswalk on Hartwell Avenue near Linden Street. This crosswalk was first established in August of 1964. This crosswalk has been

"enhanced" 6 times in the past 45 years. The signing and marking seen today was approved in 1996 and upgraded again in 2000. There will be a cost of approximately \$10,000 total to enhance the crosswalk with flashing sign technology and to install a new ADA crosswalk ramp on the east side of N. Hartwell. At this time, there is no budget item to make this level of improvements. Also, staff has not collected any data on the usage of the crosswalk and has not talked with Parks & Rec on cost share of

any improvement. Staff recommends no action on this item.

<u>ID#15-3732</u> To establish a safe crosswalk from Springbrook South crossing Racine

Avenue to Minooka Park.

Recommendation: Staff has conducted an initial review of this item. The nature of this request is to have a

crosswalk installed on Racine Avenue near Springbrook South and leading into Minooka Park. Racine Avenue at, this location is CTH Y and is under the jurisdiction of Waukesha County. Waukesha County would have to approve any crosswalk on Racine. Additionally, there is no existing sidewalk infrastructure available on Racine or Sunset Drive to accommodate a crosswalk. It is unadvisable to install a crosswalk when there is not proper ADA ramps and sidewalks (or paths) leading to a point of destination. Currently, Sunset Drive, from Racine Ave to Minooka Park is under the jurisdiction of the Town of Waukesha and they would have to approve any sidewalk

connectors. Staff recommends no action on this item.
