3. Discussion and Recommendation re:

A. ID#16-328 Approve a No Parking zone on the west side of Baxter Street from the

southern most Schuetze Center parking lot driveway to 120 feet south. -

(item amended to be 160 feet south).

Recommendation: Referral was made by Public Works and the Parking Agents. PD Parking Agents are

concerned about vehicles parking too close to a crosswalk on Baxter Street. This crosswalk goes from the Sheutze area near the river to White Rock school. Existing No Parking zones on the west side of Baxter Street to no adequately prevent parking too close to the crosswalk, bus stop and a nearby fire hydrant. The No Parking zone requested in this item will provide a clearer curbside area in this busy location.

This item was placed on hold from previous meeting. Committee felt that the no parking zone requested will remove too many parking spaces. The police department reviewed this request and took measurements in the field and they agree with the proposed No Parking zone from the driveway to 120 feet south.

Public Works staff and Police Department recommends approval of this request.

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B. ID#16-0729

Modify parking restriction in Alley 18 off South St. to be the following: Sign 1 – "No Parking Any Time Except for Loading Zone" and Sign 2 – "1 Hour Loading Zone, MON – FRI 8AM-5PM, SATURDAY 8AM TO 12PM"

Recommendation:

Referral was made by Ald. Helgestad on behalf of a nearby business owner who uses Alley 18 to move supplies in and out of the business. Alley 18 is a very narrow alley currently posted No Parking Any Time. The request is to provide a way for the business owner to legally park in the alley way for a period of time to load and unload. The proposed changes would be installed on two signs. Sign 1 - "No Parking Any Time Except for Loading Zone" and Sign 2 - "1 Hour Loading Zone, MON - FRI 8AM-5PM, SATURDAY 8AM TO 12PM". Staff supports this change and recommends approval.

Modify parking restrictions in Parking Lot 8 to create 8 parking spaces on west side of the lot, behind 403 and 407 N. Grand Avenue to be 3 Hour Parking, Monday through Saturday, No Permit Parking Allowed.

Recommendation:

Referral was made by Ald. Helgestad on behalf of businesses at 403 and 407 N. Grand Avenue who have patrons that utilize Municipal Lot 8 to park for access to the businesses. Converting the 8 stalls to be "no permit" stalls would allow for a 3 hour parking period but not have permit parkers using the stall all day. Staff supports this change and recommends approval.

D. ID#16-0731

Modify existing No Parking 8am – 4pm, Monday - Friday on the north side of Dolphin Drive to be from the west driveway to the east driveway of 1814 Dolphin Drive.

Recommendation:

Referral was made by Public Work on behalf of a business owner at 1815 Dolphin Drive. The business owner at 1815 has issues with semi trucks not being able to back in or pull out of their driveway during the day when cars are parked along the north side of Dolphin Drive at 1814 Dolphin. There is an existing No Parking zone along north side of Dolphin Drive from the west driveway of 1814 to 150 feet east. This request will extend the parking zone further east to be at the east driveway to 1814 Dolphin Drive. The extra distance will keep parked cars clear of the driveway are and allow for greater clearance for semi trucks to maneuver. Ald. Thieme supports this change. Staff supports this change and recommends approval.
