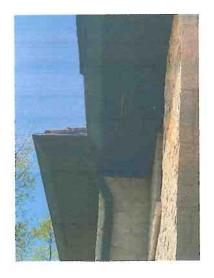

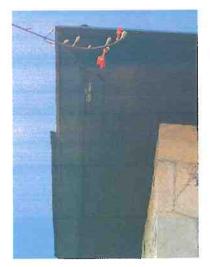

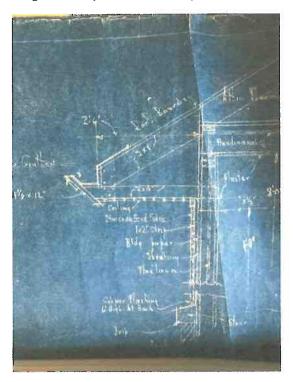








Original blueprint detail and profile of k-style exterior gutter.
