Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as filling of a swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.

Review and act on the request from Taibi Mrioued for a one-time sewer credit for 200 E. Laflin Avenue.

Taibi Mrioued, on April 19, 2023, requested a credit for sewer service charges for the time period of March 2023 for an outside faucet that froze and leaked into the yard. This outdoor water use was not treated by the Clean Water Plant.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was compared with the period of heavy usage.

High Usage: 11,300 gallons (2023) Average Usage: 2,806 gallons

Estimated Additional Usage: 8,494 (2023)

Calculated Refund (2023 – \$10.48/1000 gal): \$89.02

Options & Alternatives:

To not approve the one-time sewer credit or approve another dollar amount.
