**Details:**

Effective for the 8/14/18 Partisan Primary, four (4) city poll locations will be moved out of school locations. The site selections have been approved by the Dept. of Justice per our ADA compliance Settlement Agreement. Polling location moves are necessary due to school security issues and ADA compliance. Moving the City's poll locations out of schools was identified as a high priority item in the Strategic Planning sessions.
