## Subject:

Approval for Changes to Bus Stops

#### Details:

This item is to seek the approval of changes to the bus stops on the south side of E. Sunset Drive and E. Moreland Blvd. The portion of E. Sunset Drive from the new Meijer development east to the 164/59 Bypass will be under construction this year and staff reviewed the bus stops in that area to see if any adjustments to the stops should be made in conjunction with the construction project. The following changes are recommended: 1. Eliminate the bus stop on E. Sunset Dr. opposite of W. Camden Way. This stop will still not have any sidewalk or bus stop pad after construction and is next undeveloped land in the Town of Waukesha. 2. Move the existing bus stop on E. Sunset Dr. opposite of E. Camden Way approximately 10 ft west of its current location. The new location would have a bus stop pad which currently does not exist and will be adjacent to a new crosswalk on E. Sunset Dr. The changes to the bus stops on E. Moreland Blvd. are to eliminate the bus stops on E. Moreland at Cleveland (south side of the street) and E. Moreland Blvd. at Murray (north side of the street). E. Moreland will also be under construction and these stops are determined to be not needed because 1. Both have low ridership 2. There are other more heavily used stops a block or two way.

## **Options & Alternatives:**

No other viable alternatives exist.

#### Financial Remarks:

The cost associated with eliminating/moving the bus stops is minimal and the bus stop pad and sidewalk improvements are included in the construction project costs.
